

Requirements for The Legal Marriage Ceremony in Jamaica

The Law requires that the Bride & Groom are in Jamaica for a minimum of 24hrs prior to the wedding. In order to get legally married by the Marriage Officer recognized by the Jamaican Government you must apply for a License ahead of time. Listed below is a list of documents required by the Jamaican Government to apply for your Marriage License:

1. Notarized copies of Bride & Groom's birth certificates which must include father's name.
2. Notarized copies of Bride & Groom's official Id (Passport)
3. Notarized copies of divorce decrees or death certificate (if applicable)

These documents must be sent to the wedding planner\ coordinator at least four weeks before the couple's arrival to the country. It is highly recommended that you use a private courier service such as Fedex, DHL or UPS)

Cancellation Policy

Cancellation can only occur in the case of the Legal Ceremony, after you have already submitted your paperwork if you must cancel the wedding date due to unforeseen reasons. There will be a cancellation fee of US\$100.
